



ART of the DJ™

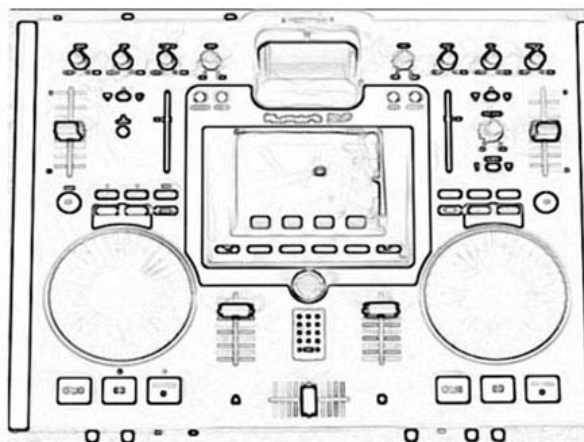
Class Description

In the 21st century, POPular music is defined by the Disc-Jockey (DJ), who produces and manipulates musical sounds into the digital recordings that children and young adults are fascinated by everyday on the radio, their MP3 players and on YouTube. DJs today are world touring, headlining talent... that means there is a lot more than just spinning wheels on a turntable, CD player or computer! EVERYONE wants to be a DJ, BUT do they know what it takes?

With the ART of the DJ™ program, students learn about the music, equipment, and art required to become a DJ. The class teaches students what to do on the microphone (which boosts their self-confidence), how to create artwork to market themselves (includes digital art, photography and video), how to put together their playlist (Top 5 songs with an emphasis on clean lyrics) and everything required to produce their own mix or show! This is a highly creative cultural enrichment and educational program that nurtures students' genius and helps manifest their dreams. ART of the DJ™ is a Music & Arts Society program, founded by Jesse Saunders (Originator of House Music, music producer, consultant and original member of the world famous Chosen Few DJs), and Evelyn Thompson (Artist, designer, writer and speaker).
